MINUTES HISTORIC DISTRICT DESIGN REVIEW MEETING September 17, 2014

Mr. Abell also said he wants the sign to be clear and direct so when someone drives by in a car the sign is effective. Ms. Duman said she would like to see the MayDay Inc. logo larger but that they could leave all the other content the same.

Mr. Storz made a motion to approve the application and Big Deal Grant from MayDay Inc., with a second from Ms. Marlette the motion carried. Ms. Mehaffy said even though the application has been approved as is, she would encourage MayDay Inc. to utilize Mr. Abell as a design consultant.

3. Main Street Banners. Mike Kee stated Sara Locate had contacted him and expressed interest in writing a grant to obtain funds put up banners on Resort Street. Mr. Abel said HBC was already working on a plan for Resort Street banners.
