Building Inspector III

The City of Baker City is seeking applicants for the position of a Full-time Building Inspector III.

Applicants with a background in the construction field are encouraged to apply.

General duties include inspecting one and two family structures for structural, mechanical and plumbing compliance with State

codes; performs residential plan reviews; inspects manufactured dwelling set-up installations and alterations. Position also provides administrative and clerical support to the Building Department and assists in the administration of the standard operating policies and procedures of the department.

Minimum requirements: The City of Baker City will provide on the job training for the success-

ful applicant.

Applicants should have the ability to hold and maintain State of Oregon ICC Certifications for Residential Inspections (structural, mechanical, manufactured dwelling and plan review).
