



Firefighter/Paramedic

The City of Baker City is currently accepting applications for the purpose of establishing an Eligibility List for Fire Fighter/EMS Providers (EMT and Paramedic). The City of Baker City anticipates hiring at least one 56-hour position from this list.

Brief Job Description: Protects life and property; performs firefighting, emergency aid, hazardous materials and fire prevention duties; performs ambulance driving and life saving duties; drives and operates fire apparatus and equipment; maintains Paramedic status; performs routine maintenance and custodial work on station and equipment; actively takes part in department training activities. Important Dates:

- 1st Review: June 15, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. Applications must be received by this date and time to be considered in the first review.
- 2nd Review: June 30, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. Applications must be received by this date and time to be considered in the second review.

Testing will include a written exam, medical scenario assessment, physical agility test and interview. Candidates will be placed on a list based on the final scoring which will be weighted 40% for the written exam and 60% for the oral interview process.

Preference Points: Preference points will be added to the overall score following the written exam and the oral interview process. Veterans preference points are available to candidates who qualify and will be added to final score to determine placement on the list: **5 points** for Veterans OR **10 points** for Disabled Veterans. Baker City employees serving in the paid part-time program, and meet minimum requirements, are eligible to receive 5 preference points.

Minimum Requirements: 18 years of age or older; legally allowed to work in the United States, high-school diploma/GED; a drivers license valid in Oregon; must pass physical examination, drug screening and background check (pre-employment); Oregon Licensed Paramedic upon hire; DPSST NFPA Fire-fighter 1 or equivalent upon hire.

Salary and Benefits

Current salary range: \$4,443 to \$4,998 per month plus incentives (additional 5% for Intermediate, 10% for Paramedic) Excellent benefits package to include vision, dental and medical insurance, retirement and vacation leave are added benefits.
